### **Ride Route for 9/11 Fire Fighters Sunrise Gathering/Ride to OCC**

In preparation for the IAFF-MG 9/11 Tribute Ride from Newburgh to the FDNY Fallen Fire Fighters Memorial in NYC, the IAFF/IAFFMG Riders will stage at the Motorcycle Pedia Museum for a Sunrise gathering and ride through the City of Newburgh, past their firefighters memorial to pay our respects to their fallen and to ride into OCC to stage for the 9/11 Tribute Ride to NYC.

The FDNY Fire Riders will be leading the way and escorting us into the staging area then onto NYC.

### **As an FYI, the route the FDNY Fire Riders have planned is as follows:**

Make left out of parking lot onto Lake Street. Go approximately 1mile (3<sup>rd</sup> light) make right on Broadway and take it to the end. Make a left on Colden Street and go to the light. Make a left onto North Street. Go past the Newburgh Memorial (approximately 1mile). Continue past the memorial and continue to the end (approximately 1mile) Make a right on Robenson Ave. toward Route 84 and get in the left lane. After underpass make a left at the light. Stay in the left lane and at the next light make a left onto Route 84. Stay on Route 84 for approximately 4.5mies. Get off Route 84 at Exit 6. Make a left onto 17K (Shell station on the left) and go approximately 2 miles and re-stage for NYC ride (Kick Stands Up @ 10am).[EVERYBODY should re-fuel (top off). At exit make a right you will have a Pilot, Mobil, and Gulf down the road]. We will be staging at either the Auto Auction Lot or just on 17K past OCC HQ. Just follow the FDNY Riders and they will take us were we need to be.

We will be departing OCC at 1000 for the 9/11 Tribute Ride to NYC. Once at the Fire Fighters Memorial we will have a brief service/laying of the wreath. Once the service is concluded riders will be released to pay their respects, visit Fire Stations in the area, migrate to WTC Memorial site, stop for lunch or depart NYC back to Newburgh or home. We will be providing different ride route for your review, consideration and use back to Newburgh for the IAFF-MG Rally Closing.
