Kelly Crush, 49, is a retired fire fighter from the Wichita Falls Fire Dept., Station 8, in Texas. Crush's involvement with MDA has spanned more than 20 years, participating in MDA's Fill-the-Boot program each year. He's been instrumental in raising funds and awareness, and participated in the 2009 broadcast of the MDA Labor Day Telethon. He resides in Ft. Worth, Texas, near his sisters, Annette and Carol. Crush is affected by ALS, also known as Lou Gehrig's disease. In ALS, nerve cells that control muscle cells are gradually lost. As these motor neurons are lost, the muscles they control become weak. ALS ultimately causes complete paralysis while leaving mental functions intact. Survival is typically three to five years after diagnosis, without assistive technologies such as mechanical ventilation and feeding tubes.
